It was moved by Councilmember Buenaventura, seconded by Councilmember Daus-Magbual and carried to close the nominations.

It was moved by Mayor Sylvester, seconded by Councilmember Buenaventura and carried by unanimous roll call vote to appoint Councilmember Manalo to serve as Vice Mayor of the City of Daly City for the ensuing year.

Personnel Board Commissioner Perla Ibarrientos administered the oath of office to the new Vice Mayor, Juslyn C. Manalo.

The Council expressed their appreciation with a special gift to Councilmember Buenaventura for his leadership as Mayor during the past year, for his outstanding mentorship, and for strong leadership in the time of transition.

Councilmember Buenaventura expressed appreciation to the strength of the entire Council and the help of the City Manager through this tough year.
