The meeting was called to order by Recreation Commission Chair Teresa Proaño at 6:00 p.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion made by Commissioner Pastor seconded by Commissioner Meafua to approve the November 25, 2014 Minutes. Unanimously approved.

ADMINISTRATION OF OATH TO NEW TRUSTEE: Mayor Raymond Buenaventura Administered the oath of Office to Denise Kelly.

REPORTS

1. Director's Report:

- A. Proposed Changes to Daly City Municipal Code, Dogs in the Parks – Director Curran mentioned that the Daly City Municipal Code does not allow dogs in the park. Director Curran is proposing to allow dogs on leashes at all times and is in control by a competent person in the park. The Commissioners agreed to include this item for further discussion in their next meeting.
- B. Updates on Youth Leagues:
Recreation Services Manager Brown presented to the Commissioners both the Youth Flag Football and Mini Hoops Programs.
 - Youth Flag Football Program –This is designed to teach the fundamentals of football and to provide low-key competition and fun for boys and girls. Participants range between 3rd through 8th grade. Participants may only play within their own grade level. The three divisions were Pee Wee, Junior and Senior. We had 14 teams and 160 participants.
 - Mini Hoops Program - This program is designed for boys and girls in the 1st and 2nd grade. Their goal is to teach good sportsmanship in teams sports while introducing basketball skills in a fun environment. The kids go to the clinic and end with the teams playing “mini” games on lowered baskets. There were 93 registrations.
 - Youth Basketball Program – Mr. Ray Reyes, Recreation Coordinator, presented to the Commissioners the Youth Basketball for Boys and Girls 3rd through 6th grade. This is instructional with special rules to emphasize fundamentals and fun. The rules are more modified and lenient for newcomers to the sport. The Daly City Youth Basketball League is designed to provide a positive environment, low-key competition, and a focus on good sportsmanship. This is a 10-week program. Players are placed on teams. Assigned to 1 ½ hours practice once a week. All plays are games are played on Fridays and Saturdays. Approximately 50 games per weekend.

There are 1,220 boys and girls participants. Championships at War Memorial is scheduled for March 16-20, 2015 from 5:30 to 8:30 p.m.

- C. Senior Spotlight – Recreation Manager Brown gave the Commissioners an update on Senior's Program. We currently offer Ukelele for Beginners on Thursdays at 9:30 a.m. for \$5 per class, at Westlake. Ukelele Intermediate is offered on Thursdays at 11:30 a.m. for \$5.00 per class, at Westlake. Ukelele at War Memorial on Mondays, at 3:00 p.m., \$2.00 per class. Kanikapila Jam, 1st Saturday of the Month, \$3.00 per class, at Westlake.
