REPORTS:

1. Director's Report:

- A. Discussion of Recreation Commission Meeting Time - Mr. Curran said that this item is placed for discussion at tonight's meeting per the request of Vice-Chair Kelly. This item is about considering to change the Regular Recreation Commission Meeting time. He said that the Recreation Commission Meeting time and place is set by the Daly City Municipal Code. Any change needs to go before the City Council meeting on a public hearing to make an amendment to the Daly City City code. Vice-Chair Kelly said that her reason for requesting the time change is to ensure a quorum each monthly meeting. The Commissioners recommend to City Council to change the start time from 6:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. (MSP: Kelly/Pastor)
- B. Update on the Summer Youth Recreation Program - Ms. Brown provided the Commissioners an update of the Department's Summer Youth Recreation Program. The Program is held at 5 locations – Marchbank Park, Westmoor Park, Hillside Park, Westlake Park and Gellert Park. There were 2 program options - full day and half day. There was also a pm care option, an extended care for 2 hours following the camp end time. The Programs include 8 Themes –*Out of this World, Splash Into Summer, All American Summer, A Super Adventure, S/more Summer Please, Daly City Got Talent, Animal Extravaganza, and Carnival Fun Time*. Arts and Crafts, Field Trips, Rec and Reading, Cooking Classes, Junior Giants, and Special Events are also part of the program. One of the local field trips was to go to Pump it Up and other trips chosen by staff. Lunch is provided at all sites except for Gellert. Ms. Brown also talked about the Volunteer Leadership Program (VLP). This is an opportunity for teens in 8th-12th grades to perform community service at our Summer Youth Recreation Program. This program promotes professional growth and personal development.
