1. Director's Report:

A. Athletic Fees – Field, Gym and Tennis Courts:

The turf field will be replaced this summer. The field will be closed from June through August, leaving the City with just one soccer field (Pollicita) for most of the summer. The Field also has a drainage problem. This Agenda item will be discussed in the next Recreation meeting.

B. Budget Update:

Director Curran said that the City of Daly City is dependent on two funding revenues - sales and property taxes. The City was hit by recession and has fewer resources compared to other cities in the Peninsula. Director Curran and staff are trying to piece together a balanced budget for the upcoming 2 year cycle. The City Council will hold a special meeting looking into the preliminary budget of the Department of Library and Recreation Services on May 16, 2016.
