APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Motion made by Commissioner Proano and seconded by Commissioner Pastor to approve the April 26, 2016 Agenda. Unanimously approved.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion made by Commissioner Pastor and seconded by Commissioner Proano to approve the March 22, 2016 minutes with the revision on Commissioner's Report to add the National Women's History Month and add comments made by Kay Christensen. Unanimously approved.

ADMINISTRATION OF OATH: Council Member Dave Canepa introduced Ms. Vivian Araullo as the newly elected Recreation Commissioner. Ms. Annette Hipona, City Clerk, administered the oath of office to Ms. Vivian Araullo as the new Recreation Commissioner.

DIRECTOR'S REPORTS:

1. Youth Basketball Season Review, Edgardo Bolanos, Recreation Program Supervisor – Mr. Bolanos presented to the Commissioners the 2016 Youth Basketball League for Boys and Girls 3rd through 8th grade. The 3rd grade league is instructional with special rules to emphasize fundamentals and fun. The rules are more modified and lenient for newcomers to the sport. The entire league is designed to provide a positive environment, low-key competition, and a focus on good sportsmanship. Registration started in October and ran through early December. Kids who signed up individually were placed on Daly City teams. The league was open to residents and non-residents from random schools. Teams consist of 6-10 players. School teams were also allowed to participate and a team rate. The new eligibility for the 2016 league were that school teams will only comprise of students attending at that school. We wanted to concentrate on keeping everything fair and that everyone participating in our program is not untruthful about anything. Player eligibility required that players must be enrolled in the school they intended to play on. All teams are coached by volunteers. Mr. Bolanos thanked the coaches for helping. This was a 10-week program. Each Daly City team was assigned to a 1 ½ hour practice slot, once a week, with a minimum of 7 games. Team practices began the week of January 16th. All games were played on Fridays and Saturdays. There were over 913 boys and girls who participated, 112 teams and over 150 volunteer coaches. Over 36 referees and 16 scorekeepers, usually high school students, assisted with the league. Play-offs started on March 10th. A free Basketball Clinic was offered last November 12, 2015, with over 80 participants. This was sponsored by Youth for Fitness and Education (YFE). Mr. Bolanos hope to work with other agencies in the future.
