REPORTS:

1. Director's Report:

- A. Sports Tourism in Daly City – Commissioner Sison provided the Commission with an Executive Summary of a report he submitted that included a section entitled, *Development of Sport Tourism Strategy*. Commissioner Sison stressed that San Francisco and other Bay Area cities were reaping financial benefits of sport tourism, while Daly City lacks the infrastructure to better position itself as a destination for tourists. He mentioned that Daly City's close proximity to San Francisco is advantageous to creating opportunities for tourism. He noted that with the addition of hotels and other tourist serving amenities, Daly City could be a tourist destination.
- B. Parks and Facilities Master Plan - Director Curran informed the Commission that the Department of Public Works would be preparing a Request for Proposals to assess the current state of Daly City's facilities and parks in order to prioritize future capital improvement projects. The Request for Proposals will likely be made by the end of the calendar year.

- C. Summer Youth Recreation Program – Director current stated that a comprehensive report summarizing the 2016 Summer Youth Recreation Program would be made at the September 27, 2016 Commission meeting.

COMMISSIONERS' REPORT:

- Commissioner Sison asked for a report detailing the number of participants and revenue generated from summer recreation programs be made available at the next meeting.
