2. Westmoor High School Master Plan – The High School is currently undergoing a major 100 million capital improvement plan including a new baseball field, softball field, theatre, tennis courts. They plan to build new 6 tennis courts that can be used by our community during non-school hours. In the meantime, their baseball field has been dispersed so the HS approached us if they can use some of our baseball fields i.e. Gellert and Marchbank and Jefferson as well. Then there is the Westmoor Clubhouse which is not owned by the City but the School District. The long standing lease of 50 years expired this year and the School District is not interested in extending the lease. They would like to expand their administrative office.
