REORGANIZATION OF THE COMMISSION

Commissioner Sison nominated Commissioner Pastor to be Recreation Chair. Unanimously approved.

Commissioner Pastor nominated Commissioner Sison to be Recreation Vice-Chair. Unanimously approved.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT:

1. Partnership with Daly City Baseball Association (DCBA) – Director Curran said that this is a relatively new baseball association in Daly City for youth baseball. They are officially a non-profit 501c3. The group is hoping to reenergize youth baseball in Daly City by offering a competitive opportunity to the older kids up to 14. The Department and the Association have come to an agreement for the Recreation Division to run the TeeBall/Farm leagues and the Association to take over the 9 to 14 year olds. The Association will offer a baseball summer camp at Westlake Park, South Diamond; and it will run a week long from 8:00 a.m. -4:00 p.m. The Department will handle all the registration in the main office. The fee that the participant pays will be split 50-50 between the Department and the Association. The camp will be administered by DCBA staff.

2. Garden Deli Menu and Price Adjustments - Deli is operated by volunteers from the Doelger Senior Center. The Deli is located at Westlake Park in the courtyard across from the Administration Office. The Deli operates from 9:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m., Monday through Friday. The Deli has been experiencing a deficit despite the fact that it is run exclusively by volunteers, with the assistance from one part-time employee. They have not adjusted their sandwich prices in years. The Department would like this program to be at least a break-even operation. With the proposed price increase, it should narrow the gap by the end of this fiscal year. A 50 cent increase to all sandwiches is recommended.
