DIRECTOR'S REPORT:

1. Recreation Commission Commendation for Life Guards – Cole Oliver, Jennifer Gittins, Christine Chen and Tiffany Chen – Director Curran commended our four lifeguards for their heroic life-saving efforts. On Sunday, February 12, 2017, a patron suffered a very serious health problem at the Giammona Pool. The four lifeguards were able to stabilize and comfort him until he was transported to Stanford Hospital where he immediately underwent a surgery. He called after he was discharged from the hospital and thanked our four lifeguards for their intervention and calm demeanor. At tonight's meeting, these four fine individuals were recognized for their valiant efforts.
2. Youth Basketball Recap - Mr. Edgardo Bolaños, Recreation Program Supervisor, presented to the Commissioners the 2017 Youth Basketball League for Boys and Girls 3rd through 8th grade. It started in January and ended in late March. This league is designed to provide low-key competition with special rules to emphasize sportsmanship and fun and provide a positive environment. The rules are more modified and lenient for newcomers to the sport. This is a 10-week program. Players are placed on teams and are assigned to one 1 ½ hours practice once a week. All games are played on Fridays and Saturdays. There were 900 participants, 109 teams and over 130 volunteer coaches. There were 32 referees and 16 scorekeepers. A free Basketball Clinic was held November 12, 2016 and had more than 80 participants. The Clinic was presented by SF Basketball Academy.
3. MH Tobias Video, Afterschool Youth Recreation Program – Director Curran distributed a disc video, a year book and newsletter put together by MHTobias AYRP to each Commissioner.
