MINUTES – SEPTEMBER 26, 2017

The meeting was called to order by Recreation Commission Chair Pastor at 7:00 p.m.

ROLL CALL

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion made by Commissioner Landos and seconded by Commissioner Sison to approve the August 22, 2017 Minutes. Unanimously approved.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT:

1. Considering New Fees for 2018 Youth Basketball League –Director Curran is seeking endorsement from the Commissioners to be brought to the City Council to adopt a new fee structure for the 2018 Youth Basketball Program. The Daly City Youth Basketball League is designed to provide a positive environment, low-key competition, and a focus on good sportsmanship. The Department anticipates all fees going up like referees' fees, staff wages, equipment and uniform. Director Curran is proposing a fee increase to the team fees from \$331.00 to \$430.00 and practice fee from \$110.00 to \$150.00.
2. Summer Youth Recreation Program Recap – David Zetzer, Recreation Program Coordinator, presented this year's SYRP. The program ran for 10 weeks. Our five sites locations are Marchbank Park, Gellert Park, Westmoor Clubhouse, Hillside Park and Westlake Park. A total 16 field trips and weekly swim trips. A video was shown to the Commissioners that captured the exciting moments during the summer program. A big thank you to Christopher Joe for creating the video. Last year, the Summer Youth Recreation Program provided a safe, fun, and creative environment for more than 2,300 children through the course of 10 weeks plus 2 bonus weeks.
3. Considering New Fees for 2018 Summer Youth Recreation Program –Director Curran is seeking endorsement from the Commissioners to be brought to the City Council to adopt a new fee structure for the Summer Youth Recreation Program. Due to the anticipated rise in the cost of providing the program, staff proposed raising the weekly to \$98. The proposed fee includes some onsite camp activities that required extra fees in the past years, simplifying the registration process and creating a more inclusive environment for all SYRP participants. The new rates will be introduced in June 2018.
4. National Fitness Court Size Selection – The National Fitness is an outdoor fitness area. It's a new fitness court for the 21st century. Parking, visibility, land, bike access and pedestrian access are to be considered when picking a site. The four possible sites where we might be able to install the equipment are Sullivan Avenue, Lincoln Park, Hillside Park and Westlake Park.
