DIRECTOR'S REPORT:

1. Fiscal Year 2018-19 and 2019-20 Budget –Director Curran said that the City is still focusing on strategies for coping with the still existing structural deficit that the City of Daly City is struggling for a couple of years now. The Department of Library and Recreation Services was directed to reduce expenditures for the coming 2-year budget cycle of \$269,000. The Department is not contemplating layoffs. The Department is proposing new revenues to offset the budget reduction target. Daly City, on average, charges less for programs and facility rentals compared to neighboring communities. If the Department proceeds with fee increases, it should help narrow the gap between expenditures and revenues.
