MINUTES – AUGUST 28, 2018

The meeting was called to order by Recreation Commission Chair Jack Pastor at 7:00 p.m.

ROLL CALL

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Motion made by Commissioner Luna and seconded by Commissioner Landos to approve the August 28, 2018 agenda. The agenda was unanimously approved.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Commissioner Landos made a motion to approve the minutes of the June 26, 2018 meeting. Commissioner Luna seconded the motion. The motion was unanimously approved.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT:

1. Daly City Dolphins Update – Brian Galli, President of the Daly City Dolphins Aquatics Club Board of Directors, presented the commission with an update of the club's activities. Mr. Galli stated that the club is growing steadily after a few austere years. He also told the commission the club was interested in becoming involved in more community activities, including serving as volunteers. Mr. Galli introduced the head coach of the club, Mauricio Ponce. Mr. Ponce said his goal is to grow the club to 90 members.
2. Aquatics Volunteer Programs – Romeo Benson gave the commission an overview of the volunteer program at Giammona Pool. He said participants in the volunteer program assist instructors, while receiving training that will help them develop their own swimming skills. Volunteers at the pool are easily identified by their blue rash-guard shirts. Staff at Giammona Pool wear red shirts. At the conclusion of his report, Mr. Benson showed a short video about the program.
3. Parks and Open Space Master Plan - Mr. Curran informed the commission that the Parks and Open Space Master Plan process is underway. The stakeholders group is meeting with staff and members of the consultant team preparing the plan, Gates and Associates. Mr. Curran said the consultants just recently completed a phone survey of more than 400 Daly City residents. He also said the consultants would be looking for community input at upcoming events – including the Latino Heritage Month at City Hall on September 15, and at Kasayahan sa Daly City – the Fil-Am History Month

Celebration scheduled for October 13, at Marchbank Park. Commissioner Landos volunteered to serve on the Stakeholders Committee with Commissioner Luna.
