DIRECTOR'S REPORT:

Center for Age-Friendly Excellence (CAFE) - Advancing Livable Communities for All Generations -- Director Joseph Curran introduced Cynthia Nakayama, Associate Director of the Center for Age-Friendly Excellence. Ms. Nakayama presented demographic data that underscored the growing older adult population in the United States. She said that by 2050, older adults will represent 22% of the world's population. In order to meet the needs of the aging population, CAFÉ espouses a principal called Eight Domains of Livability. The eight domains are: Outdoor spaces and buildings, Transportation, Housing, Social Participation, Respect and Social Inclusion, Civic Participation and Employment, Communication and Information and Community Support and Health Services.

Ms. Nakayama explained the brief history of the Age Friendly Network, which was founded in 2005. Today, more than 760 cities worldwide, are participating in the Age Friendly Network.
