MINUTES – APRIL 23, 2019

The meeting was called to order by Recreation Commission Chair Jack Pastor.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Motion made by Chair Pastor and seconded by Commissioner Flamenco to approve the agenda for April 23, 2019. The agenda was unanimously approved.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Motion made by Chair Pastor, and seconded by Commissioner Ortiz, to approve the minutes of the Recreation Commission meeting of March 26, 2019. The motion carried unanimously.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT:

Upcoming Summer Youth Recreation Program – Denise Brown introduced David Zetzer, who is in charge of the upcoming Summer Youth and Recreation Program (SYRP). The Summer Youth Recreation program is a subsidized program for youth ages 5 ½ to 14 years old. There are 4 locations for the SYRP Adventure Camp which include Marchbank, Hillside, Gellert and Westlake Park. For older kids, there is a SYRP Explorer camp that is held for 10-14 year olds at the Gellert and Westlake Locations. Gellert and Westlake are both super sites and each year they can hold up to around 140 participants at each location. The SYRP consist of 10 generalized themed weeks and activities, games, and field trips are all centered on the theme of that week. For the upcoming summer, there have been changes and additions to the SYRP camp as a whole. One of the new events is a Meet the Summer Camp Staff and Movie Night in the Park which allows attendants meet some of the summer camp staff that will be working this summer.

Review of JSD President's Week Adventure Camp and Spring Break Adventure Camp – David Zetzer also had an overview of the JESD President's Week Adventure Camp that ran from 8:00AM – 6:00PM. This was a special camp that was offered daily rather than by the week. Parents were able to choose which specific day they wanted their kids to attend and each

day had a different activity/trip. The Ski Week Adventure camp an average of 30 students per day and a total of 140 participants. In regards to the Spring Break Adventure Camp, that camp ran from April 8 to April 12 from 8AM-6PM. There were a total of around 57 participants for the Spring Break Adventure Camp.

Overview of the Volunteer Leadership Program – Denise Brown introduced Edgardo Bolanos, who is in charge of Daly City Teens. Volunteer Leadership Program is a program that gives teen that have completed the 8th grade, an opportunity to perform community service at one of the four Summer Youth Recreation Program Sites. Edgardo went into details about how to sign up for the VLP as well as what they can expect from the VLP. Some of the skills that the teens gain from the trainings and the program are leadership skills, safety, team building, and communication skills. In terms of their community service record, the volunteers will receive a logbook to track their community service hours and a letter totaling the amount of service hours they completed at the end of the program. Edgardo states that last year, there were 104 registrants and all together they completed 15,505 hours of community service.

COMMISSIONERS' REPORT:

Commissioner Nate Ortiz gave an update on the 49ers Prep Flag Football Program. Since the coaches meeting that he went to, Commissioner Ortiz has stated that he has been in communication with the program in terms of equipment and setting up camps or leagues. He is hoping to start within the third week of June and he hopes to put forward with Denise and Joseph a plan for field rentals for this particular program.

ANNOUNCEMENTS AND COMMUNICATIONS:

Denise wanted to remind the community that aside from the SYRP and VLP that there are several Sports and Enrichment Camps that are held throughout the summer.
