DIRECTOR'S REPORT: Aquatics Update – Director Curran introduced Recreation Program Supervisor Chris Mariano to update the council on the 2018-2019 fiscal year for the Giammona Pool. The Giammona Pool offers a variety of classes ranging from swimming lessons to lap/recreation swimming schedules daily. The pool also holds pool parties rentals on the weekends as well as special pool events that can be attended by everyone. For the 2018-2019 fiscal year, there has been a total of 7,132 participants for swim classes and aqua camps.
