**DIRECTOR'S REPORT:**

**Recreation Department During Shelter in Place Order** – Director Curran gave a quick update on what has been going on with the department since the Shelter In Place Order. When the order came down, facilities, parks, playgrounds and fields have all been shut down. Doelger Senior Center has also been shut down to the public, however, there is a modified congregate lunch program where seniors either receive delivered meals or the grab and go meals on Mondays for the week, that consists of five frozen meals that either get delivered to them or picked up at both the Doelger Senior Center or the Lincoln Community Center.

Director Curran introduced Romeo Benson, Senior Recreation Services Supervisor, to update the commissioners about the virtual recreation program. As of March 30<sup>th</sup>, a campaign called Daly City Rec at Home was started through social media platforms to engage the community in activities which include cooking, virtual trips, physical activities, and arts and crafts. Romeo also discussed the amount of engagement that posts receive amongst all the social media websites including Facebook and Instagram.

Romeo also brought up that they are continually updating the Daly City senior program page on Facebook. The department noticed that there was not a lot of posts for seniors on Instagram, Facebook, and YouTube and that they are a priority focus since the seniors are the ones that are most isolated.
