APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Chair Luna requested a motion to approve agenda for May 25, 2021 meeting. Motion made by Commissioner Pastor and seconded by Commissioner Ortiz. The Agenda was unanimously approved.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Chair Luna requested a motion to approve minutes for meeting on March 23, 2021. Motion was made by Commissioner Ortiz and seconded by Commissioner Pastor. The minutes were unanimously approved.

DIRECTOR'S REPORT:

1. Summer Programming Power Point presentations from members of the Recreation division.

Ray Reyes presented on a marketing strategy by doing Pop-Up Rec events on random weeks between May 31 – July 5, taking place in various areas of the City to bring awareness to the community of activities that will be available for summer. First one is the Memorial Day weekend at Gellert Park from 11a-1pm. One-week notice will be given to the community of locations where popups will take place. There will be home projects and giveaways, Library to participate in live readings, tabling and advertisement of their hours of operation.

Class Development/Cultural Arts Administrator Leslie DuBridge presented contracted outdoor and virtual classes for youth and adults. It will include martial arts, sports, performing arts, STEM and others. New contractors are participating this summer, Musical Theater - singing, dancing, acting, based on skill development. Young Rembrandts - drawing and art outdoors. Adult activities such as Country Western Line Dancing, Zumba, low intensity fitness, also outdoors.

Recreation Services Coordinator Janette Ghnaim presented summer sports in-person camps. Five camps total to include Football, Basketball, and All-Sports. There will be two sessions; AM for ages 6-10-year-old and PM for ages 10-15-year-old, and the total participants in each camp will be 25. Great instructors will be returning and taking extra measures for everyone's safety.

Recreation Services Supervisor David Zetzer presented summer events – Movie Night at Westlake Park on July 9 and July 23, 2021. Cost will be \$20 per vehicle, which includes a family fun snack pack. There will be a maximum of 50 cars and the movies are coordinated with Rec & Reading theme of the week.

Administrative Assistant II Edgardo Bolanos presented on the Volunteer Leadership Program. It will be in-person and virtual from June 28 – July 30, 2021. It will include weekly trainings, daily activities, special events, community service, and reward/prizes. Possible field trips. Advertising on social media platforms: Instagram and Facebook @dalycityrec for Volunteer Leadership Program @dcteens.

2. Second Harvest of Silicon Valley has given an infrastructure grant of \$87,303 to transition room 7 into a food pantry. It will include two refrigerators, two freezers, two sub-freezers, and one delivery vehicle with Cambro's for hot and cold food. The door to the pantry will be widened to fit pallets of food, and \$8,000 for an electrical upgrade. The Daly City Partnership will provide referrals for those in need and the clients will be able to get groceries on a weekly basis. July 2021 is the target month to be up and running.
