

CITY OF DALY CITY
MINUTES – SPECIAL MEETING - CITY COUNCIL
DECEMBER 13, 2021

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Mayor Manalo called to order the last meeting of the 57th City Council at 5:30 PM by video conference call pursuant to Executive Order N-29-20. Assemblymember Phil Ting and Senator Scott Wiener congratulated and thanked the Mayor and the City Council for their work during the past year amidst the pandemic. Mayor Manalo thanked Assemblymember Ting and Senator Wiener for their support and partnership with the City. On behalf of the San Mateo County Board of Supervisors, Supervisor David Canepa presented Mayor Manalo with a proclamation declaring Mayor Juslyn Manalo Day in San Mateo County as a testament to her resiliency during the past year and for serving as a role model. Mayor Manalo thanked Supervisor Canepa for the honor and for his continued support and partnership. Mayor Manalo led the pledge of allegiance.

PRESENTATIONS:

Mayor's Artist of the Year 2021

Mayor Manalo presented Artist of the Year to Keith Okada, better known as DJ Keith O, for lending his talents at many functions, using his music to bring community together, and giving back to the community by hosting "Keith O Kids Days."

Mayor's Small Business of the Year 2021

Mayor Manalo presented the award to Keith's Chicken and Waffles, owned by brothers Keith and Devin Richardson, for serving Southern-inspired cuisine and thriving as a small business.

Mayor's Medium Business of the Year 2021

Mayor Manalo presented the award to The Bread Basket, a Filipino bakery owned by Liza Cavin, for its hospitality and its generosity in providing donations at community feeds.

Mayor's Large Business of the Year 2021

Mayor Manalo presented the award to North East Medical Services Medical Center (NEMS), a nonprofit community health center serving the medically underserved populations of the San Francisco Bay Area, and was commended for its leadership, accessibility, and for providing responsive healthcare.

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Mayor's Citizen of the Year 2021

Mayor Manalo presented the award to Cecil Owens for serving as Board of Trustee of the Bayshore School District for over 42 years and advocacy for the Bayshore neighborhood.

Mayor's Commissioner of the Year 2021

Mayor Manalo presented the award to Perla Ibarrientos, a founder of the Pilipino Bayanihan Resource Center (PBRC) and Personnel Board Commissioner, for her civic volunteerism, mentorship and dedicated service to the community.

Mayor's Employees of the Year 2021

Mayor Manalo presented the award to Angie Padilla for her work with City Councilmembers and City Managers over the course of the 35 years she has been working for the City, and who currently works in the City Manager's Office as the Administrative Secretary/Admin. to Council. Mayor Manalo also presented the award to Tom Piccolotti for his work as Director of Water and Wastewater Services (DWWR), serving on the North Coast County Water District North San Mateo County Sanitation District and work on the Vista Grande Drainage Basin improvement project.

Mayor's Organization of the Year 2021

Mayor Manalo presented the award to Vibes and Smiles and founder Amanda Nwe; the organization was founded as an outlet for individuals and businesses to promote positivity and creativity, and to support local artists to showcase their music and art.

Mayor's Philanthropic Organization of the Year 2021

Mayor Manalo presented the award to Daly City Public Library Associates (DCPLA), an organization which supports the four branches of Daly City's public libraries and has provided over \$300k in grants to the Daly City libraries since its inception in 2011.

Mayor's Veteran of the Year 2021

Mayor Manalo presented the award to Skip Weiss, Commander of the Veterans Foreign Wars Post 8750, for dedicating 21 years of service to the Jefferson Union High School District and for his years of service in the military and to his community.

Mayor's Volunteer of the Year 2021

Mayor Manalo presented the award to Ray Satorre, Pilipino Bayanihan Resource Center (PBRC) Board Member (former President) and Planning Commissioner, for his volunteerism, mentorship and philanthropy.

Mayor's Woman of the Year 2021

Mayor Manalo presented the award to Marie Villarosa, who is the Marketing and Events Manager for the Serramonte Shopping Center, the President of the PBRC, Secretary of the Daly

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City/Colma Chamber of Commerce, the Board of Director for the North Peninsula Food Pantry, the Marketing and Communications Chair for the Daly City Hosts Lion Club and was the former Director of the DCPLA. Ms. Villarosa was commended for her community involvement, volunteerism, creativity and energy.

Mayor's Youths of the Year 2021

Mayor Manalo presented the award to Jefferson High School student Victor Duarte. Mr. Duarte is the captain of the school's soccer team and showed his leadership by also becoming their acting coach. Mayor Manalo also presented the award to Oceana High School student Madeleine Hur, who serves as a student trustee for the Jefferson Union High School District, is a member of the Associated Student Body Congress and is the first Daly City Youth Poet Laureate.

Mayor Manalo thanked her husband, parents Josie and Lito, sister Carly and nieces, friends, and children Little E and Baby J for all their support. Mayor Manalo also thanked Assemblymember Phil Ting, Senator Scott Weiner, Supervisor David Canepa and the Board of Supervisors, her colleagues in the City Council, City Manager Shawna Maltbie, City Attorney Rose Zimmerman, City Manager staff Stephen, Angie, Leilani and all City departments including City Attorney's Office, City Clerk's Office, the Economic & Community Development, Finance & Administrative Services, the Firefighters from the North County Fire Authority, Human Resources, Library and Recreation Services, Police Department, Public Works and Water & Wastewater Resources. Mayor Manalo provided a summary of the accomplishments and the City's response to the challenges of the pandemic over the past year.

CALL TO ORDER OF THE 58th CITY COUNCIL

Mayor Manalo called to order the 58th City Council for the City of Daly City and asked for roll call. All Councilmembers were recorded as present.

REORGANIZATION OF THE CITY COUNCIL

Office of Mayor

Mayor Manalo called for nominations for the Office of Mayor. It was moved by Mayor Manalo and seconded by Councilmember Buenaventura to nominate Vice Mayor Daus-Magbual to the Office of Mayor.

Mayor Manalo called for any other nominations for the Office of Mayor. Hearing none, it was moved by Councilmember Buenaventura, seconded by Councilmember Sylvester and carried to close the nominations. The motion carried with the following roll call vote:

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Dr. Arlene Daus-Magbual gave the Oath of Office for Office of Mayor to Dr. Rod Daus-Magbual. Mayor Daus-Magbual read a letter he wrote to the City of Daly City summarizing his history with the City, goals as Mayor, message to the community, and critical issues to tackle such as affordable housing and community responsive wellness. Mayor Daus-Magbual looked forward to working with his colleagues and staff to recover from the pandemic and thanked City Manager staff and fellow City Councilmembers. Mayor Daus-Magbual thanked wife Arlene, children Amianan and Razon, family from the Philippines, Canada, and the U.S., his Skyline College family, the Daus family, the Magbual family and his ancestors.

The Council thanked and commended Councilmember Manalo as the outgoing mayor for all her hard work during the past year, acknowledging her leadership, passion and ability to execute her vision and goals during challenging times.

Office of Vice Mayor

Mayor Daus-Magbual called for nominations for the Office of Vice Mayor. It was moved by Mayor Daus-Magbual and seconded by Councilmember Manalo to nominate Councilmember Ray Buenaventura for the Office of Vice Mayor.

Mayor Daus-Magbual called for any other nominations for the Office of Vice Mayor. Councilmember Sylvester voiced concern regarding issues of social justice, equity, diversity and inclusion coming to the forefront and what was occurring to be implicit bias. Councilmember Sylvester stated Daly City has no protocol on the rotation of mayors, brought up the idea of giving an opportunity to Councilmember DiGiovanni for the role of Vice Mayor, and cautioned on promoting explicit bias through this nomination. As there were no other nominations, Mayor Daus-Magbual closed the nominations. The motion carried by the following roll call vote:
