ARTIST BACKGROUND

AILEEN CASSINETTO

BORN AND RAISED IN MANILA, PHILIPPINES, AILEEN CASSINETTO IS AN ACADEMY OF AMERICAN POETS LAUREATE FELLOW AND THE POET LAUREATE OF SAN MATEO COUNTY. SHE IS ALSO THE FOUNDER OF PALOMA PRESS, AN INDEPENDENT LITERARY PRESS PUBLISHING POETRY AND PROSE.

IN HONOR OF WOMEN'S HISTORY MONTH AND INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY LAST YEAR, THE PHILIPPINE EMBASSY IN WASHINGTON DC INVITED HER TO MODERATE ITS FIRST EVER PANEL DISCUSSION FEATURING FILIPINO WOMEN AUTHORS. SHE WAS ALSO ONE OF FOUR FILIPINA AMERICAN POETS CHOSEN BY THE EMBASSY IN A BILATERAL CAMPAIGN BY THE U.S. STATE DEPARTMENT AND THE PHILIPPINE DEPARTMENT OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS TO COMMEMORATE THE 75TH ANNIVERSARY OF PHILIPPINE-U.S. DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS.

SHE RECEIVED A SPECIAL CONGRESSIONAL RECOGNITION AND WAS APPOINTED COMMISSIONER ON THE SAN MATEO COUNTY COMMISSION ON THE STATUS OF WOMEN IN 2021.
