In the body of the email, include the item number and/or title of the item as well as your comments. All comments received by 4:00 pm will be emailed to the City Council members prior to the meeting. Those comments received after 4:00 pm will be added to the record and shared with the City Council members following the public meeting. Comments are not read aloud into the record.

To speak at the meeting, you must register to join via Zoom. Please complete your registration by 5:00 pm on the meeting date in order to participate. After registering, you will receive a confirmation email containing instructions on how to join the meeting, including a unique link. Your email will not be disclosed to the public. Public comment is limited to two (2) minutes maximum, and speakers may only comment once per item.

When you would like to speak on an item during the public comment portion of the meeting, you will need to use the "raise hand" feature in Zoom. The City will not be providing technical support.
