ARTIST BACKGROUND

ALEJANDRA PALOS, A STONE SCULPTOR, WAS BORN AND RAISED IN SAN FRANCISCO'S MISSION DISTRICT. SHE IS THE DAUGHTER OF MEXICAN IMMIGRANTS AND MUCH OF HER WORK IS INSPIRED BY HER MEXICAN HERITAGE. HER GREATEST ARTISTIC INFLUENCE HAS BEEN HER FATHER, MASTER STONE CARVER, MANUEL PALOS.

ALEJANDRA HAS BEEN STONE CARVING FOR 15 YEARS, AN ART FORM THAT HAS ALLOWED HER TO CLAIM HER CREATIVITY AND OWN HER VISION OF CHANGE AND EMPOWERMENT. AS AN ARTIST AND CANCER SURVIVOR SHE USES CARVING TO SHARE HER JOURNEY OF HEALING AND SPIRITUALITY.

ONE OF HER PASSIONS IS TO EDUCATE LATINO YOUTH ON THE "LOST" ART OF MAYAN AND AZTEC STONE CARVING. BY SHARING THE STONE CARVING ART FORM WITH LATINO YOUTH, SHE HOPES THAT THEY CAN RECLAIM AND CONNECT WITH THEIR INDIGENOUS ROOTS.

HER GOAL AS AN ARTIST AND CANCER SURVIVOR IS TO CONTINUE THE CYCLE OF HOPE BY GIVING BACK TO HER COMMUNITY AND SERVING AS AN EXAMPLE FOR THOSE WHO HAVE FACED SERIOUS HEALTH-RELATED CHALLENGES.
