2. Introduction: Dragonfly Community Arts
Dragonfly presentation by James Siegel. This organization awards grants to groups who are promoting arts in the community and to groups who can reach a large group of people.

- Currently they are working in schools and at the San Mateo County Fair.
- Dragonfly is working in Daly City with the Bay Area Mural Program from Oakland. They went to Jefferson high School for six weeks to work with their art club (Grizzart!). They are painting for 3 Thursdays. Next week will be the last one and hopefully they can do Ribbon Cutting in September.
- Dragonfly is also working on a San Bruno project at Tanforan with the Sansei Granddaughters' Journey. This exhibit will run from July 24-September 3, 2022 and it honors the history of the incarcerated Japanese Americans during WWII.
- Dragonfly wants to keep expanding and they don't want to stop there now that they are on a roll. How can Dragonfly help support arts education in Daly City.
- If the patron sees a project that she is interested she will sponsor it. Her goal is to have the most educational impact on larger groups of people
- How can we expand that to give art classes inspire minds, get into classrooms, visual arts, is it sustainable and can it grow over time, will it have some staying power
- Getting a proposal, is it something that they are interested in and are there enough funds
