NEW BUSINESS:

1. Senior Art Exhibit at City Hall Octagon Gallery
 - a. Request to hold Exhibition July or later going forward
 - b. Commission can accommodate from July 11 through September 1 since the Fall reception is set for September 12. Have the opening reception on July 11 at 6pm.

Have the next Exhibit on September 12-a possible collaboration between Filipinx and Latinx artists. Consider promoting solidarity through a panel discussion and an art exhibit).

2. Review of artwork submissions

- a. Discuss the role of the Arts & Culture Commission outlined in the Ordinance and the importance of connecting with other commissions to achieve shared goals.
- b. Artist Chris Gray is looking to create a mural on a retaining wall near Junipero Serra Blvd. between Hickey Blvd. and Serramonte Blvd. This is a private wall just below Hoy Sun Ning Yung Cemetery, Chinese Christian Cemetery, and the Russian Sectarian Cemetery. There are some walls that belong to the City that the Commission can revisit. The Commission is interested in collaborating with Chris Gray to brainstorm on what we all envision for Daly City and would like to invite him to the next meeting.

3. Priority Setting (missions) for 2023

- a. This item was tabled to the June 12th Meeting.
- b. A subcommittee was formed to lay the foundation. Vice Chair Paniza and Commissioner Villaspar were nominated to head the subcommittee.

4. October event – Kasayahan and others
