DIRECTOR'S REPORT

32nd Annual Black History Month Celebration

Administrative Assistant II Edgardo Bolaños introduced Class Development and Cultural Arts Administrator Leslie DuBridge who talked about the upcoming 32nd Annual Black History Month Celebration on Saturday, February 24, 2024 at Daly City City Hall from 11:00 am - 1:30 pm. This year's themes are Black Americans and the Arts along with "Kustawi" which means to "thrive on" in Kiswahili. Some highlights of the celebration are: The Domini Hoskins Black History Museum will be having a pop-up exhibit, the Kalimba King - Carl Winters will be giving the history of and doing a demonstration of the African hand piano, complimentary henna hand art, Doelger volunteer art instructor Al Olson will be sharing his art, and the Daly City Congregate Lunch program's Food Services Coordinator, Opal Fuller will be sharing "Soulful Southern Appetizers". This event is open to all ages.

Contracted Classes

Class Development and Cultural Arts Administrator Leslie DuBridge shared an overview of Contracted Classes offered through the Recreation Services Department. There are two parts to Contracted Classes. The first part is regular classes that have offerings for most age groups such as Karate, Soul Line Dance,

Hawaiian Hula, private piano lessons, regional dances of Mexico Ballet Folklorico and Country Western Line Dance. The second part are Measure Q classes that are offered to those who are 50 years +. The low cost of these classes are \$10 for residents and \$12.50 for non-residents. Some examples of Measure Q classes are Argentine Tango, portrait drawing, Qi Gong, and Ukulele and Me.

COMMISSIONERS' REPORT

Chair Ortiz shared that he attended Frosty Fest back in December and he was amazed at how the entire Westlake Park was decorated and interactive including the inside of the gym. There were carnival type games inside the gym, free hot cocoa, and Santa. Chair Ortiz proposed that maybe for this year's Frosty Fest the Commission could help find businesses to sponsor game booths or get some kind of sponsorship funding.
