Subject: Interviews for Vacant City Council Position

Recommended Action

Hold interviews and advance the selection process through public deliberations and potential action on an Interim City Councilmember appointment.

Background/Discussion

Due to the resignation of City Councilmember Raymond A. Buenaventura, there is a vacant seat on the City Council. Under State law, the City Council may fill the position on an interim basis until a special election is held to fill the vacancy on a permanent basis. A special election has been called to coincide with the next regular municipal election on November 5, 2024.

Applications for the vacant position were accepted between February 26, 2024, and March 27, 2024. The City Council received 26 applications. All of the applicants noted below meet the minimum requirements for appointment to the City Council. Copies of the applications have been available for review by members of the public in the Office of the City Clerk.
