DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Doelger Senior Center

Director of Recreation Services Denise Brown introduced Recreation Services Supervisor David Zetzer who shared an overview of the Doelger Senior Center at Westlake Park. It operates Monday -Friday 9:00 am - 3:00 pm with Senior Specialists Karen Parque and Andrea Tsang, office staff Terry Slepnikoff, Food Services Coordinator Opal Fuller and volunteers. The Doelger Senior Center offers monthly classes, programs and special events with partners such as SamTrans, AARP, Kaiser Health and NEMS.

A wide range of activities and classes like arts and crafts, fitness, book clubs, dance, and music are available.

Westlake Park

Recreation Services Supervisor David Zetzer shared an overview of Westlake Park. It operates 7 days a week with senior, teen and youth programming. Some examples are Tiny Tot Playtime, Teen Open Gym, Go4Life fitness class, pickleball and volleyball. It is also the home to family fun events such as Frosty Fest, Trunk or Treat, and Spring Fun Day. Upcoming special events being hosted at Cafe Doelger and the Pacelli Event Center are the Senior Volunteer Appreciation Luncheon in April and the Health and Wellness Fair in May.

COMMISSIONERS' REPORT

Commissioner Montanes introduced himself as the newest Recreation Commissioner and thanked Director of Recreation Services Denise Brown, Administrative Assistant II Edgardo Bolaños, and Chair Ortiz for being so welcoming and friendly. He shared that he attended the Lunar New Year celebration at City Hall, his first Crab Feed at the Pacelli Event Center, the Black History Month Celebration, and the State of the City event where part of Mayor Juslyn Manalo's speech was about the many programs the Recreation Services Department provides to the community. He's looking forward to attending the Women's History Month Celebration on March 28 and Spring Fun Day on March 30. Lastly, he wanted to announce that Westmoore High School's Filipino Barkada Club will be hosting their annual Island Fiesta.
