DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Youth Baseball Program Recap

Administrative Assistant III Edgardo Bolaños introduced Recreation Services Coordinator Brian Flowers who shared a recap of the tee-ball and coach pitch baseball programs that wrapped up in mid May. The tee-ball program is for 4.5 – 7-year-olds and had 38 participants divided into 4 teams. The coach pitch program is for 7 – 9-year-olds and had 28 participants divided into 2 teams. The cost for both programs were \$111 for residents and \$139 for non-residents. Brian has spoken to kids at schools as well as athletic directors to gain interest however, the number of participants has stayed the same for the past two years. He's struggling to get the youth involved and to try new sports so he would like to get the commissioners help in the future to get the word out. Commissioner Montanes and Chair Ortiz said they would love to continue the conversation and work with their connections to get the word out.

Daly City Hip-Hop Day

Administrative Assistant III Edgardo Bolaños introduced Senior Recreation Services Supervisor Romeo Benson who presented on the first Daly City Hip-Hop Day in recognition of the August 11 Hip-Hop

Day. Daly City's Hip-Hop Day will be on August 10, 2024 at War Memorial Community Center from 11:00 am – 5:00 pm. There will be a 2 V 2 breaking competition, DJ sets, hip-hop museum, Olympics – men's breakdancing watch party, merchandise vendors, activities for children and free food while supplies last. They will also be doing a tribute to DJ Swift Rock. Chair Ortiz, a team member on the Hip-Hop committee who's assigned to activities, shared that this year is the "pilot" year and they hope this is an event that Daly City can host annually. There's a lot of hip-hop history in Daly City so they're relying on that for a good turnout.
