REGULAR MEETING MINUTES – NOVEMBER 26, 2024

DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Overview of the Build a Dream Scholarship Program

Director of Recreation Services Denise Brown introduced Administrative Assistant III Edgardo Bolaños, who gave an overview of the Build a Dream scholarship. At the October 12, 2024 City Council meeting, council approved the update to the Build a Dream scholarship program. The scholarship provides financial assistance to youth, teens, and Active Adults 50+ enabling them to participate in exercise education and cultural art programs offered by the Recreation Services Department. Changes were made to the eligibility policy to clear up who is eligible: Daly City residents between the ages of newborn to 17 years old or active adults 50+. Applicants now only have to apply once a year, whereas before they had to apply every quarter. Instead of getting a discounted rate on one activity, awardees will have more flexibility and will receive a fixed amount to use for the year. They are also broadening what activities are now eligible with scholarship funds - all programs will be eligible. Any amount not used at the end of the year will be recouped and put back into the fund. Since COVID, they have been working toward building the scholarship back up from \$1,000 to now over \$35,000 through donations and fundraising efforts. So far they've been able to help families pay for after school programs. They're looking forward

to 2025 to enact the new scholarship policies. They are currently having a “Build a Dream Holiday Tree Lot” at the Westlake Park parking lot. For your donation of \$100 you can pick out a 5-6 foot noble fir tree or for \$120 you can pick out a 6-7 foot noble fir tree. All money made will go straight to the Build a Dream scholarship fund. They have 200 trees to sell. Also, in January they will be having a Spaghetti Feed with all proceeds going toward the Build a Dream Scholarship fund.

Aquatics Overview

Director of Recreation Services Denise Brown introduced Recreation Services Coordinator for Giammona Pool, Brian Sai. He talked about the Summer programs that were offered: Aqua fit, lap swim, aqua camp, swim lessons, pool parties, recreation swim and a lifeguard course. He also talked about current Fall programs that include aqua fit, lap swim, recreation swim, swim lessons and pool parties. Days and times offered for programs differ every season.

Mini Hoops Basketball Overview

Director of Recreation Services Denise Brown introduced Recreation Services Coordinator Brian Flowers who gave an overview of the Mini Hoops Basketball program. The program is for children 5 - 7 years old. This year there were two sessions. The first session ran for 6 weeks from September 6, 2024 - October 12, 2024 and had four different classes on Fridays and Saturdays. The second session is also 6 weeks: November 8, 2024 - December 20, 2024 and has 2 different classes on just Friday nights.

COMMISSIONERS' REPORT

Chair Ortiz asked Administrative Assistant III Edgardo Bolaños to update the Commission on Volleyball court rentals. At the War Memorial Community Center and Pacelli Gym they offer drop-in volleyball open gym where individuals sign up and rotate in with others and share a court. Court reservations that allow your own private group to play together are also offered. In order to serve more people in Daly City, they decided to offer more drop-in open-gym. Facility rentals of gyms are another option for groups who want to hold practices, leagues, and tournaments.

Commissioner Montanes shared that he attended Kasayahan in October and it was the biggest that he's seen so far. It was the 10th year and there were many food trucks and other vendors.
