2025 Reflection

Vice Chair Luna shared that she thinks the Recreation Department continues to do amazing work for the community with so many events, programs, and services offered. She's excited to have a new Commissioner on board and what will come of that. Commissioner Ortiz shared that 2025 was a year to be proud of. The events last year are a reflection of what they want the events to be going forward. Commissioner Marcelino shared that although he joined the Commission late in the year, from the events he did attend in the past, he sees the growth and is excited to be a part of the Commission and what they can do together as a team. Chair Montanes described 2025 with the word "expansion". Events like Hip

Hop day were once a dream and in 2025 the 2nd annual Hip Hop day grew 10 fold with vendors, sponsorships and activities.

2026 Yearly Goals

Chair Montanes recapped the Commission's current goals of fundraising - including sponsorships from companies and corporations in the community and more engagement as commissioners with planning and providing more support to staff. He would also like to focus on recruiting a fifth member to the Commission. Vice Chair Luna added she would like to see how they could be more involved with Recreation's regular programming as well; not just with events. Commissioner Ortiz pointed out afterschool programs, active adult congregate lunch, and summer programs are other areas that they as commissioners can volunteer at. Chair Montanes suggested attending as many events and programs as they can, try to be a part of at least one planning committee for an event and to volunteer at one event. Commissioner Ortiz suggested a 1-2-3 guideline: 1 committee, 2 events, check out 3 programs. Chair Montanes congratulated Commissioner Ortiz for winning "Commissioner of the Year" at the re-org ceremony.
