An event where Daly City residents can support local vendors. SF Kollektive assists small businesses starting up with permitting and compliance, marketing, and promotion. They are projecting 50-100 vendors with low cost vendor fees of \$50-\$100. While their 501(c)(3) status is pending, any collaboration with the department will be put on hold until that status is cleared.
